Cafeteria: Due to the rising cost of food the cafeteria will raise the cost of lunch to \$3.00 starting January 7th, 2025, this is the first price increase of lunches since 2017.

Our Saviour Athletic Fees

As we reach the midpoint of the 2024-25 school year, this is a reminder that OSS Extracurricular Participation Fees are expected to be paid prior to the first contest of the season in each sport or activity. With all our Fall Sport seasons completed, we are still missing several participation fees. Baseball & Softball fees this year were \$135. We are missing one from each sport. The Cross Country & Girls Basketball fees were \$75 and we are missing three from each sport. Boys Basketball & Cheerleading fees are also \$75. We are missing nine basketball payments and two cheerleading payments.

Just a reminder – students must sit in the gym if they are attending a sporting event. They are not allowed to run around the school/concession area, nor play on the carpeted ramp in the gym. Thank you.

Weather –Please remember to send your student(s) with a jacket/coat. We will go outside most days unless it's raining or the feels – like temperature is 18 degrees. Also, label your items, so we can get them back to the owner if they are misplaced!

Late Start: Once again, Our Saviour School will be utilizing "Late Start" days due to extreme wind chill temperatures or icy road conditions. As we coordinate with Jacksonville School District and Routt Catholic High School, on late start days, school will begin two (2) hours later than usual and buses will run their regular routes unless otherwise noted. Whereas our doors typically open at 7:45 a.m. and the last bell rings at 8:05 a.m., with this "Late Start" option, our doors will open at 9:45 a.m. and the last bell will ring at 10:05 a.m. Those using the Jacksonville bus service in the morning, the bus will pick you up 2 hours later. "Late Start" is an option to allow school districts to continue with school (while starting later) and therefore, eliminating the use of a snow day. The decision for wind chill and ice situations should be made by approximately 5:30 a.m. I will send out a notice via School Messenger as soon as determination has been made. Please note — while we try to coordinate bus schedules with Jacksonville School District, we do NOT necessarily follow their weather-related schedule. We will send a School Messenger if OUR schedule changes.

Lost and Found: Please have your child check the lost and found as sweatshirts and ³/₄ zips are beginning to pile up. We also have a few water bottles.

JSD 117 Bus Service: Just a reminder that if JSD 117 is not in session and we are, you will need to make other arrangements for your child to get to and from school. We do not necessarily follow their weather-related cancellations, etc. You will be notified via School Messenger on weather-related closings. Also, the local radio and TV stations will be contacted.
